3. After appraisal, another grant of @Rs. five lakhs to each science departments of the Colleges with Potential for Excellence may be released. In case of Autonomous colleges, additional grant of Rs. 10 lakhs may be considered after appraisal.
4. Colleges which have been rated as 'A+' by the NAAC according to the old methodology and 'A' accordingly to the new methodology which are not yet covered under the above scheme can be considered for a grant of Rs.10 lakhs each.
5. Number of fellowships can be raised from 5 to 10 in case the concerned department can admit more than 10 as per specified procedure.
6. The Committee decided to call the following departments for presentation for Networking Centre on November 7, 2008 at 3.30 p.m.

 2. Division of Biological Sciences, IISc., Bangalore. (subject to confirmation from the Chairman, Empowered Committee..)
