Sub: Nomination under Cultural Exchange Programme/ Educational Exchange Programme.

Sir,

The University Grants Commission intends to implement certain items of Cultural Exchange Programmes/ Educational Exchange Programme (EEP) entered into by the Government of India with foreign countries. These interalia provide for visits of Indian teachers to these countries for a study-cum lectures, exchange of views, establishing contacts and training for various periods. The teachers nominated under this programme would be provided to and fro travel by the University Grants Commission and the maintenance in the foreign country would be provided by the host Govt. as per the provisions of the relevant Cultural Exchange Programme. The nominated teacher would be required to be paid full salary and allowances for the duration of his/her visit abroad and may be treated as on duty as per University rules.

I am enclosing a statement (Annexure-I) indicating the placements available and the duration of visits, for your information.

The Commission would be grateful if the above information is brought to the notice of the teachers in the University and its affiliated colleges. Interested teacher may apply to the University along with their bio-data and work plan. The University may with the help of a Committee nominate, not more than three teachers for consideration of the Commission under the programme during 2008-2009 and send their bio-data and work plan (in triplicate) to the undersigned in the proforma attached (Annexure-II) latest by 15th May, 2008. The applications received directly from applicants, will not be considered by the Commission. The decision of the Commission will be final. The teachers who have availed UGC/University assistance during the last three years need not apply.
