Dear Sir/Madam,

This is in continuation to my letter of even number dated 20<sup>th</sup> October, 2008 regarding submission of the proposals of the Colleges under “**Colleges with Potential for Excellence**” (CPE) scheme duly scored by the University as per the scores prescribed by the UGC for different parameters. The last date for submission of the proposals to the UGC was 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2008.

A few Universities have requested for extension of time for submission of proposals to the UGC. As such, it has been decided to extend the date for submission of proposals for the CPE scheme upto **15<sup>th</sup> January, 2009** for the Universities, which could not submit the proposals till 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2008. No further extension shall be given thereafter.

You are therefore, requested to submit the proposals of the eligible colleges duly scored as per the scored parameters of the UGC and as per terms and conditions already conveyed to the Universities positively before **15<sup>th</sup> January, 2009**.
