Sir/Madam,

As you are aware, the University Grants Commission has been implementing the scheme of Human Rights Education and inviting proposals regularly every year from Colleges which are included under section 2(f) and 12(B) of UGC Act. Accordingly, all the eligible and interested Colleges are requested to submit their proposals as per the prescribed proforma made available in the guidelines of the scheme. The guidelines of the scheme may be downloaded from the website of UGC namely www.ugc.ac.in.

The financial assistance is available for introduction of Foundation Course (2-3 months), a Certificate Course (3-6 months), an Undergraduate Course / a Postgraduate Diploma Course (9-12 months), a Postgraduate Degree Course, an Integrated Masters Programme in "Human Rights Education" and for organizing Seminars/Symposia/Workshops, for Moot Court / Mock Trial, for encouraging publication of Books and Journals and for Promotion of Human Rights standards, Social Concerns and Human Development. The assistance will be provided till the end of XI plan only.

All the eligible Institutions may note that separate proposal may be sent for each component of the scheme and the proposal may be submitted through Registrar of the Concerned University. The proposal should reach the office of UGC latest by **15th November, 2011**.
