



There is no uniformity in the inspection fee charged by many Universities. In many cases the University insists on sending a large team of experts for inspection.

It is suggested that experts who are locally available may be selected by the universities for inspection purpose which would reduce the financial burden on the applicant institutions.

4. Need for prompt response

The experience of the NCMEI has been that many of the universities do not respond to the notice issued by the Commission. In certain cases even after issue of 2 or 3 notices, no response has been received. . No response from the concerned Universities or regulatory authorities would force the Commission to take decision ex-parte which may adversely affect the interests of the University concerned.

It is requested that the Universities should send prompt response to the notice issued by the NCMEI.
