
Dear Sir/ Madam,

In order to promote quality and excellence in selected Universities in India, the Commission had introduced a scheme entitled 'Universities with Potential for Excellence' (UPE) during IX Plan period. During IX Plan period in Phase-I the Commission had selected five Universities JNU, Madras University, Hyderabad University, Pune University and Jadavpur University under the scheme.

During X Plan Period the Commission had selected 4 Universities viz Mumbai, Madurai Kamaraj, North-Eastern Hill University and Calcutta under the UPE Scheme.

Recently, the XI plan guidelines for UPE scheme has been formulated and a copy is posted on the UGC website www.ugc.nic.in.

In case your University is interested, then it may download the guidelines from the website and send a proposal as per the prescribed proforma (Annexure-I) to UGC.


