Dear Principal,

At the outset, I would like to congratulate you, your staff, students and your management for the unique honour of 'CPE' status bestowed on your college.

You may be happy to know that your College is one among the 50 Colleges identified under the scheme "Colleges with Potential for Excellence" (CPE) during phase-II. I do hope that you would have received the letter sent to your Vice-Chancellor **and copy marked to you in this regard**. The information regarding your college selection and other details have also been posted on the UGC website (www.ugc.ac.in).

Kindly arrange to send a certificate to the fact that the data provided by your College in the proposal are factually correct, if not sent earlier. It may be noted that in case it is found to be incorrect at a later stage then the CPE status conferred on your college may be revoked, as per the provisions of the CPE guidelines. Your Action Plan proposal shall be processed only on receipt of this certificate.

In order to have a homogeneous evaluation of the colleges and to save time, it has been decided that the Principals of the colleges may be asked to present their Action Plan alongwith budgetary requirements for the years **2006-2007, 2007-2008 and 2008-2009** before the meeting of the Expert Committee constituted for the purpose **at UGC Office, New Delhi**, as per the details given below:

Time : 10.00 – 5.00 P.M.
Venue : **UGC, Bahadurshah Zafar Marg, New Delhi- 110 002.**

Kindly note that Principal should attend the above meeting without fail and you may reach the venue atleast one hour in advance

You may kindly note that the college will be visited for an on-the-spot evaluation after a few months, the details of which will be sent to you in due course. Therefore, I request you to kindly prepare an Action Plan as per the guidelines on CPE (a copy of which can be seen at UGC website) and bring ten copies of the same for placing before the Expert Committee. You may kindly note that 60% of your Budget need to be spent on Non-Recurring and 40% on Recurring items. Since the tenure of the scheme is only for 3 years, no building component be included in the Budget.

During the interaction with the Committee you may briefly highlight the achievements of the college and the proposed plan of action along with the budget required (with justification) for the years 2006-2007, 2007-2008 and 2008-2009.

You may bring your own laptop for presentation before the Committee and a few teachers to assist you at the meeting (LCD projector and other necessary infrastructure shall be made available). You may highlight the following during your 30 minutes of presentation.

After your presentation, there shall be discussion for 30 minutes.

The allocation for your college will be as per the financial assistance indicated in the guidelines. The entire allocation will be released to you during the years 2006-2007, 2007-2008 and 2008-2009. Therefore, you may prepare your budget only for three years. The Committee may advise you to redraft the proposals based on the discussion. Therefore, kindly bring your college letter pad, seal, etc., to carryout the changes immediately and had it over to this office, for taking necessary further action.

In case your college has been accredited by the NAAC and/or awarded Autonomous status after the submission of your proposal to UGC under CPE scheme, kindly arrange to send a copy of the certificate of accreditation given by NAAC and a copy of the UGC letter conferring Autonomous status to your college.

Pending the above exercise, an ad-hoc grant of 50% of the allocation allocated to your college has already been released to your college separately. **However, the ad-hoc grant may be utilized only after receiving the approval of your budget**, which will be communicated after your interaction with the Expert Committee.

No change of date and time will be allowed in the interface meeting with the Expert Committee, as it will have a chain reaction with regard to other colleges.

No TA/DA will be paid for attending the above meeting.
