In continuation to this office letter number F.3-1/2000 (PS) dated 4th April, 2000 and [F.1-6/98 \(PS\) dated 24.4.2000](#) vide which the UGC Regulations on minimum qualifications for appointment for Career Advancement of Lecturers, Readers and Professors in Universities and Colleges were issued, it is to inform you that the Ph.D. degree holders whose examinations were completed by 19th September, 1991 (irrespective of date of declaration of results) shall be eligible for relaxation of 5% of marks from 55% to 50% to appear in Net.


Dear Sir/Madam,

In continuation to this office letter of even number dated 4th April, 2000 vide which the UGC Regulations on minimum qualifications for appointment and for Career Advance of lecturers, readers and professors in universities and colleges were issued, it is to inform you that for the Ph.D. degree holders who had passed Masters' degree prior to 19th September, 1991, a relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks at the Master's level to be eligible to appear for NET.
