The university is governed by the act of its Incorporation, statutes and various authorities stated in the act. The authorities are; Board of |

Management, Academic Council and the faculties. Sponsoring body i.e. the society which has sponsored the university, namely the Pacific Academy of Higher Education and Research Society, nominates the Chairperson of the university and five persons in the Board of Management. The Chairperson appointed by the sponsoring body also nominates one expert of Management and one expert of Finance in the Board of Management of the university. The sponsoring body that is the Pacific Academy of Higher Education and Research Society is a society registered under the Rajasthan Societies Registration Act, 1958 at registration no. 45/Udaipur /95-96 dated October 17, 1995.

The Trust i.e. the sponsoring body which is a registered society under the Rajasthan Society Registrations Act is now governed by the act of its incorporation except the aforesaid nominations/ appointments. The Act provides for certain officers for the University to conduct all its affairs. The officers provided in the Act of the University are-the Chairperson, the President, the Pro-President, the Provost, the Proctor, the Deans of Faculties, the Registrar and the Chief Finance and Accounts Officer. The statutes of the University provides for two more authorities, namely, the Secretary and the Finance Secretary with specific duties prescribed in the statutes, under clause 21 & 22 respectively. The University is thus governed by the authorities and officers prescribed in the Act of its incorporation with the officers/nominees to be appointed or nominated by the Act. The promoting body of PAHER University is Pacific Academy of Higher Education and Research Society. The Composition of Governing Body of Society is attached as Annexure- II.
