In exercise of the power conferred upon him under section 39(2) (ii) of the Patna University Act 1976 (As Amended by the Patna University (Amendment) Ordinance 1981, the Chancellor Patna University has been pleased to approve the following Regulations relating to Bachelor of Library & Information Science and order that these may be published in official gazette and brought into immediate effect.

*Admission*

Regulations for the Bachelor of Library & Information Science (B.Lib. & Inf.Sc.)

Qualification for Admission.

1. (a) Any registered candidate may be admitted to the examination for the Bachelor of Library and Information Science Degree not less than one year after passing the B.A., B.Sc. or B.Com Examination, or an examination recognised by the Academic Council as equivalent thereto, if he has completed a regular course of study for one academic year in the Institute of Library & Information Science, Patna University admitted for this purpose.

(b) A candidate, who has been sent up for the Bachelor of Library and Information Science Examination but who has either failed to present himself or to pass, may be admitted to the subsequent examinations within the next five years without further attendance at lectures in the Institute.

COURSE OF STUDY AND SUBJECT FOR EXAMINATION.

2. A candidate for the Bachelor of Library and Information Science examination shall be examined in the following subjects:-

Reports prepared by the candidate as a part of his/her session's work in paper-Group 'C' shall be submitted by him/her to the Director of the Institute at least one month before commencement of the University examination and evaluation shall be made. External and one internal examiner jointly shall

3. The examination in Sessional work under paper D shall consist of three parts relating to (i) Observer's Report (ii) Project report and (iii) Viva-Voce Examination.

4. A candidate who has failed in Group 'A' and 'B' under clause 2 above but passed in Group 'C' is exempted from being examined again in paper D group 'C' of Clause 2 if he/she so desired and marks so obtained in the previous examination shall be carried over to the subsequent Examination.

5. In order to pass the examination a candidate must have obtained 36% marks in each theoretical paper and 40% marks in each practical paper prescribed and at least 40% marks in aggregate. The candidate is required to pass in the theoretical and practical papers separately.

6. Each successful candidate who obtains 60% marks or above in the aggregate, shall be placed in the first class, and those obtaining 50% or above but below 60% marks in the aggregate, shall be placed in the Second Class.

The remaining successful candidates, shall be placed in the third class.

7. As soon as possible after the examination, the examination board shall publish a list of successful candidates, in order of merit in the first and second class and the rest in alphabetical order.

8. Each successful candidate on admission to the Degree of Bachelor of Library and Information shall receive a Diploma in the prescribed form.
