Subject : Inviting proposals for establishment of Deen Dayal Upadhyay Centres for Knowledge Acquisition and Upgradation of Skilled Human Abilities and Livelihood (KAUSHAL KENDRAS) in universities and colleges under NSQF.

Dear Sir/Madam,

Realizing the importance and the necessity for developing skills, the University Grants Commission has introduced the scheme for establishment of Deen Dayal Upadhyay Centres for Knowledge Acquisition and Upgradation of Skilled Human Abilities and Livelihood (KAUSHAL KENDRAS) in universities and colleges during the XII Plan with the objective of development of skills among students and creating work ready manpower on large scale. The KAUSHAL Kendras will endeavour to maintain a pyramidal structure of student enrolment with respect to Diploma, Advanced Diploma, B.Voc. and further studies. The guidelines of the scheme have been posted on the UGC website [www.ugc.ac.in](http://www.ugc.ac.in).

All the universities and colleges recognized under Section 12(B) of the UGC Act and eligible to receive General Development Assistance from the UGC and which have either been accredited by the NAAC / NBA or have applied for accreditation are eligible for UGC assistance under the scheme subject to the fulfillment of the criteria as laid down in the guidelines. Self financing institutions accredited by the NAAC / NBA are also eligible for consideration under the scheme without any financial assistance from UGC. They will abide by the guidelines of UGC as amended from time to time. Applications may be submitted under different categories as detailed in the guidelines.

Interested universities and colleges are requested to send their proposal as per the prescribed proforma i.e. Annexure-I of the guidelines of the scheme to the Education Officer (CC), Bahadurshah Zafar Marg, New Delhi – 110 002 latest by 31.01.2015. Proposals received after the due date and incomplete in any respect will not be considered.

All universities are requested to circulate this notice to their affiliated colleges also.
