The university was sponsored by the Pacific Academy of Higher Education and Research Society and was incorporated with the inheritance of the Institutes/ Colleges that were offered by the sponsoring body along for the creation of this university, with their movable and immovable properties specified in the schedule 1 of the aforesaid act.</p> <p>The university is spread in an area of 42.91 acres and has the following faculties: Faculty of Dental Science, Faculty of Management, Faculty of Commerce, Faculty of Engineering, Faculty Computer Applications, Faculty of Pharmacy, Education, Faculty of Hotel Management, Faculty of Science, Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities and Faculty of Mass Communication. The Dental Faculty and its hospital are situated One kilometer away from the main campus.</p>

Apart from these all other courses run by the University are as per Section 22 of UGC Act. It may be noted that in the DCI norms there is no recognition of the Ph.D. program in which 63 scholars are enrolled.

The international reference standard books are not available. The University is itself publishing journals in the field of Management, Engineering, and Hotel Management.

- e. Sports Facilities : Adequate facilities for indoor and outdoor sports are available in the University including open ground for Cricket, Football, Badminton, Basket Ball, Volley ball, Tennis Court, Gymnasium and other indoor sports facilities. 














A. General Observations and suggestion
