Kindly find attached a copy of the letter No. 3-1/2012 –NER dated 27th November, 2017 received from the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India regarding provision of concession for the wards of Kashmiri migrants for admission in Higher Educational Institutions in other parts of the Country. The Ministry of HRD has communicated its decision to extend the following concessions to the Kashmiri migrant students applicable to the academic session 2016-17 and onwards till further orders (copy enclosed).

- (i) Relaxation in cut off percentage upto 10% subject to minimum eligibility requirement.
- (ii) Increase in intake capacity upto 5% course-wise.
- (iii) Reservation of at least one seat in merit quota in technical / professional institutions.
- (iv) Waiving of domicile requirements.

You are requested to take appropriate necessary actions for compliance in the matter. These concessions may also be brought to the notice of the colleges affiliated to your university for compliance.
