NOTICE FOR INVITING PROPOSALS FOR FRESH INDUCTION
AT DEPARTMENTAL RESEARCH SUPPORT (DRS) LEVEL (2014 – 19)

The main objective of the programme is to identify and support university departments which have the potential to undertake quality teaching and research in various educational disciplines including allied disciplines.

UGC is now inviting proposals from interested university departments for fresh induction at DEPARTMENTAL RESEARCH SUPPORT (DRS) level under the Special Assistance Program. A University department which qualifies as per the XII Plan Guidelines (available on the UGC website: www.ugc.ac.in) is eligible to apply under the scheme.

Procedure for Applying:

The interested university departments that fully satisfy the eligibility conditions as laid down in the XII plan guidelines may submit online application through the following URL: www.ugc.ac.in/sap. **After successfully filling the details online, the university is required to take three printouts of the summary sheet, get them duly signed and forward three hard copies of the proposals with the summary sheet as the topmost sheet to the following address:**
