**NOTICE FOR INVITING PROPOSALS FOR FRESH INDUCTION UNDER SAP (DRS-I LEVEL) - 2015**

The Special Assistance Programme of UGC is intended to encourage the pursuit of excellence and teamwork in advanced teaching and research to accelerate the realization of international standards in specific fields. The main objective of the programme is to identify and support university departments which have the potential to undertake quality teaching and research in various educational disciplines including allied disciplines.

UGC is now inviting proposals from interested university departments for fresh induction at DRS level under the Special Assistance Program. A University department that satisfies the eligibility criteria as per the XII Plan Guidelines of the scheme (available at [www.ugc.ac.in](http://www.ugc.ac.in)) of the scheme may apply under the scheme, i.e.

***“A University department which qualifies under section 2 (f) and 12 (B) of the UGC Act,1956 and has potential to undertake quality teaching and research can submit its proposal for induction under SAP. The department should have at least six teachers including one Professor) to become eligible for induction under SAP.”***

**Procedure for Applying:**

The interested university departments that fully satisfy the above eligibility conditions may submit online application through the following URL: <http://www.ugc.ac.in/sap>. After successfully filling the details online, the university is required to take three printouts of the summary sheet, get them duly signed and forward three hard copies of the proposals (with the summary sheet as the topmost sheet) to the following address:
