

## **Indo-Hungarian Scholarship Programme**

### *Call for Applications for Hungarian students*

As per the provisions mentioned in the Indo-Hungarian Educational Exchange Programme, signed between the Ministry of Human Capacities of Hungary and The Ministry of Human Resource Development of the Republic of India on 19<sup>th</sup> November, 2014, the Indian Government through the University Grants Commission offers **35** scholarships for Hungarian students per year to pursue studies in select institutions of Higher Education in India.

### **Available Scholarships:**

The Indian Government shall offer scholarships to 35 Hungarian students per year to pursue studies in India according to the following framework:

1. 10 scholarships for BA/BSc or MA/MSc studies per year for university students for full-time studies in the English language. Students applying for these programmes shall have an appropriate knowledge of English on a certain level that is defined by the host institution.
2. 5 scholarships per year for PhD studies in English language. Students applying for these programmes shall have an appropriate knowledge of English on a certain level that is defined by the host institution.
3. 20 scholarships per year for postgraduate courses primarily for Hindi language studies, or other disciplines and research. The part time scholarships may vary between 2 – 10 months.

### **Cases of non-eligibility:**

- Foreign citizens with a residence/immigration permit or in the course of applying for such a permit in India.
- Foreign citizens with permanent residence in India.
- Foreign citizens employed on a permanent basis in India.
- Applicants in employment applying for part-time or correspondence study programmes.

### **General Provisions:**

The scholarships are valid for studies in Indian Institutions of Higher Education, for studies in fields defined in the Educational Exchange Programme. Scholarship holders must stay in India during the entire period of their studies or research. If necessary, scholarship holders may leave for one, maximum for two months at a stretch. In case of longer absence, the scholarship holder may lose her/his scholarship status.

The application must contain the following documents:

1. Application form (completely filled and signed by the applicant)
2. Curriculum Vitae
3. Certificate of the applicant's level of language necessary for the selected programme
4. Copies of the Mark sheets and Certificates from School leaving to the last examination passed.
5. Copy of the passport
6. Medical certificate of satisfactory health condition.

PhD programme applicants must attach the following documents in addition to the above:

1. Detailed research plan (min. 2 pages)
2. Two letters of recommendation

- **Exemption from paying any fees for studies or research**
- **Free appropriate accommodation for females only**
- **Scholarship holders staying in India for more than one month are covered for medical treatment in case of sudden illness. Except emergency cases none of the costs of dental care are covered. Scholarship holders staying in India for less than one month are advised to make their arrangements for insurance coverage.**

**NOTE:** Travel expenses to India, within India and back to the country of origin shall not be covered by the Indian side.

The stipend may not be effectuated immediately upon arrival in India. Therefore, scholarship holders are advised to have sufficient amount of money to cover their living costs for at least two months in India. Apart from the outlined above, the Indian party shall not compensate for any other costs related to the scholarship holder's stay.

2. Should have passed the 10+2 High school leaving Examination or equivalent with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics.
3. Should have a valid SAT score.
4. Age should not be more than 25 years as on 1st July of every year.
5. Should have a valid Passport.
6. Should have obtained a valid score in English Language Qualifying Examination such as (i) British Council Language Test (IELTS) or (ii) TOEFL (For students whose medium of instruction is not English).
7. The Institution from which the candidate obtained his/her high school leaving certificate must be accredited by the appropriate authority of their country.
8. A write up to 300 words (approximately) from the applicant stating the reasons(s) for asking admission in Jadavpur University, India and the purpose of study.

**Procedure**

1. The application should contain the following documents :
