**1. BACKGROUND OF THE UNIVERSITY:**

University of Patanjali was founded and established as a self financed (Private) University by an Act of the Legislative Assembly of the State of Uttarakhand vide Act No.4 of 2006 dated 5<sup>th</sup> April, 2006. An Organization of Patanjali Yog Peeth Trust- New Delhi – A public Charitable Trust Registered under Indian Trust Act by Sub Registrar of West Delhi District vide Regn. No.4017/4 dated 04<sup>th</sup> February, 2005.

**Vision of The University:**

The University was established with the Philosophical Vision of his Holiness Swami Ram Dev Ji Maharaj and Pujya Acharya Sri Baikrishan Ji Maharaj to give new dimensions to the Philosophy of Yoga and Ayurveda, the oldest traditions not of India but of the world to attain self knowledge, self wisdom, self glimpses, self reformation, self enlightenment and self realization also to control and remove all the physical deformities, diseases and disorders.
