Sub: Payment of Hospital Patient Care Allowances / Patient Care Allowances to category C & D (Non-Ministerial) employees working in Medical Colleges/Hospitals of Central Universities w.e.f. 01-09-2008.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to UGC's letter No. F. 30-2/1993 (CU) dated 18.09.2009 and 17.10.2012 in which the issue of payment relating to Patient Care Allowance (PCA) to Group C & D (Non-Ministerial) employees of Medical Colleges /Hospitals / Health Centres of Central Universities been raised.

2 The Ministry of Health & F. W. vide OM NO. Z. 28015/119/2012-H dated 17.12.2012 has doubled the rate of the HPCA/PCA to all eligible Group C & D employees working in Hospitals, Dispensaries and Organisations in the Central Government w.e.f. 01.09.2008 with the approval of Cabinet and DoP&T. The amount of HPCA/PCA would be automatically raised by 25% every time the Dearness Allowance on the revised pay structure goes up by 50%. This is subject to the following terms & conditions:-

- i. HPCA/PCA may be admissible in case the individual proceeds on leave/training for less than one calendar month.
- ii. HPCA/PCA may not be admissible in case the individual proceeds on leave/training for more than one calendar month.
- iii. HPCA/PCA should not be admissible in case of unauthorized leave.

3. With the approval of the competent authority it has been decided to extend the benefits contained in OM NO. Z. 28015/119/2012-H dated 17.12.2012 given by M/o Health & Family Welfare to its category C & D (Non-Ministerial) employees to all eligible Group C & D employees working in Medical Colleges /Hospitals of Central Universities under Department of Higher Education, subject to the same terms and conditions as contained in M/o Health & F.W. OM NO. Z. 28015/119/2012-H dated 17.12.2012.


OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Doubling of existing rate of Payment of Hospital Patient Care Allowances/Patient Care Allowances to eligible Group 'C' & 'D' (Non-Ministerial) employees working in Hospitals, Dispensaries and Organizations w.e.f. 1.09.2008.

The undersigned is directed to convey the approval of the Union Cabinet for doubling the existing rate of payment of HPCA/PCA to all eligible Group 'C' & 'D' employees working in Hospitals, Dispensaries and Organizations in the Central Government from the period w.e.f. 01.09.2008. The amount of HPCA/PCA would be automatically raised by 25% every time the Dearness Allowance on the revised pay structure goes up by 50%. This is subject to the following terms & conditions:-

- (i) HPCA/PCA may be admissible in case the individual proceeds on leave/training for less than one calendar month.
- (ii) HPCA/PCA may not be admissible in case the individual proceeds on leave/training for more than one calendar month.
- (iii) HPCA/PCA should not be admissible in case of unauthorized leave.

This issues with the approval of Department of Personnel & Training vide their D.O. No.21012/01/2010-Estt.(AL) dated 18th October, 2012 and U.O. of even number dated 11th December, 2012.
