Report of the UGC Expert Committee for considering the proposal of Invertis University, Bareilly (U.P.) (Private University) for inclusion of its name in the list of recognized universities of the UGC.

I. BACK GROUND OF THE UNIVERSITY

Invertis started its journey 13 years ago in 1998 with 83 students and one institute namely, Invertis Institute of management Studies. Today it stands as a full fledged University with 7 institutes to its credit under the patronage of its name and offering a range of graduate and post graduate programmes varying from management, technical, pharmacy, Law, Journalism, Architecture and sciences with the use of technology and with a team of dedicated faculty and staff members, as a consequence of Act No.22 of the UP Legislation Assembly July,2010.

Invertis is not only known for its aesthetic infrastructure and lush green gardens, it is also acknowledged for the quality of life in the campus. With 241 online IEEE journals and about 33000 books it has reasonable reading materials.

OBJECTIVES OF THE UNIVERSITY

The objectives of the University include:

- (a) To provide for instruction in such branches of learning as University may, from time to time, determine and to make provisions for research and for the advancement and dissemination of knowledge and skills;
- (b) To impart and promote study of science, engineering and technology, Bio and Medical Science, Dental Science, Pharmacy, Management, Hotel and Hospitality Management, Law and other Professional courses and also History, Culture, Commerce, Economics, Humanities, Philosophy, Art etc. through in-campus, off-campus, off-shore-campus and satellite centres or by conducting centres or by distant educational programmes etc.;
- (c) To provide education and training including correspondence and such other courses, to such persons who are not members of the University, as it may determine;
- (d) To establish and maintain schools, centres, specialized laboratories or other units for research and instructions as are in the opinion of the University, necessary for the furtherance of its objects;
