Bahrain Universities Model United Nations – 12th edition

Kingdom of Bahrain / 25-28 November 2016

The program:

This program is organized by the Ministry of Youth and Sport Affairs, for local as well as international universities. It is a representation and simulation of the United Nations' debates and meetings. Students from different universities and countries will have the opportunity to meet with their peers, and discuss the challenges that face the world today. These are challenges of different fields, such as the international peace and security, economic and social development and human rights. The program aims to consolidate the idea that constructive dialogue today can achieve good solutions tomorrow.

The participants gain many skills in the program such as public speaking, teamwork and negotiation skills. They also have the opportunity to learn about current international issues. Each participant will represent a different country with different cultures and values. This promotes acceptance and tolerance towards other cultures.

Aims:

- Strengthening leadership skills in the participants.
- To provide participants with public speaking and negotiation skills, as well as the art of dealing with an audience.
- Directing the attention of the youth towards current international issues.
- Promoting the thought of accepting others' opinions and differences.
- Providing young people with the skills of scientific research, and encouraging them to be creative.

Program period:

- 4 days, including arrival and departure.
- The BUMUN is an annual program in the Kingdom of Bahrain

Conference program:

- Forming sessions as per the protocol of the United Nations in discussing current international community issues, and voting on recommendations and suggested solutions.
- Awards are presented to distinguished participants.

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Topics of the meetings:

General Assembly:

- Cyber security and protection against cyber warfare.
- Adapting to recent development in small arms and light weapons.

ECOSOC:

- Empowering women economically.
- Evaluating the impact of global narcotic drug control.

Security Council:

- The threat to international peace and security council by terrorist acts.
- Threat of North Korea on its neighbors.

IAEA:

- Bioterrorism.
- The environmental consequence of nuclear energy.

Participation in the Dialogues:

1. Each country can participate with a maximum of 5 universities.
2. Each university can participate with a maximum of 4 participants of both genders, a coordinator for each university and a head of delegation nominated by the youth authority.
3. The participating country must choose a coordinator that will supervise the participants training, providing his/her name, contact number and email.
4. The participant must be a university student.
5. The participant must be of good behavior.
6. The participant should be fluent in the English language, because all dialogues will be in English.
7. The participant must have good research and writing skills.
8. The participant must be active in student activities.
9. The participant should have a background on international community issues.
10. The Kingdom of Bahrain will provide internal transportation for the delegates.
11. The participant countries will provide the airlines tickets and accommodation for their delegation.

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How to participate:

1. Select the delegation for the United Nation dialogue model.

4. The coordinator of the program should pass on the students' the training booklet and advise the students in preparing the research of the country they will represent.

Final Rating:

- The hosting country and the representative Secretary General will be responsible for preparing the final report at the end of the conference. The report will include the participant's opinions and recommendations that will then be passed on to be reviewed by the Youth Committee.
- Invite a representative of the Secretary General and the program supervisor to attend the program sessions.
