

**Sub: Approval of skill-based courses to be offered by HEIs under NSQF and extension of the existing Community Colleges and B.Voc courses**

The list of institutions which have been approved to offer courses under NSQF from the academic session 2018-19 is enclosed herewith. The list of institutions which have been granted extension to run their existing vocational courses is also attached. The institutions should run the approved courses from the current academic session itself, and the courses should be run in conformity with the UGC NSQF Guidelines. Guidelines are available on the UGC website, [www.ugc.ac.in](http://www.ugc.ac.in) Approved intake for each course is 50 students.

Financial assistance to the eligible institutions will be considered only when the institutions are successful in admitting atleast 15 students per course. Institutions are required to confirm the status of admission of students in the approved courses by uploading details regarding intake of students on a web portal by 15.10.2018. The portal will be made available shortly, and the link to the portal will be intimated to the institutions through a separate notice on the UGC website.

Since all further correspondence with the institutions will be made via email, institutions are requested to share the name of the nodal officer and the contact details of the officer (mobile number and email id) by sending an email to [ugcskillbureau@gmail.com](mailto:ugcskillbureau@gmail.com) by 20.09.2018.
